## Prerequisite Courses

Linfield College requires several prerequisite courses be completed prior to matriculation into the nursing major. Some of these may be in progress at the time of application, but all must be completed by the program start date.

All coursework for the major, including prerequisites, must be completed with a grade of “C” or better. Students must achieve a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 in all courses that will transfer to the major to be considered for admission. A 2.75 GPA does not guarantee admission. It is the minimum to be considered for admission. Generally, Anatomy/Physiology, Microbiology and Computer Applications must have been completed within the last seven years (counting back from the application deadline).

Clackamas Community College students intending to transfer to Linfield’s nursing program must complete the following coursework:

Two quarters of **writing**. Complete two of the following:

One year of **biology** and/or **chemistry** with lab. Complete three of the following:

BI 101, 102, 103, 112, 211, 212, 213;

One year of **anatomy and physiology** with lab. Complete all three of the following:

BI 231, 232, 233.

One quarter of **microbiology** with lab. Complete the following:

BI 234.

One quarter of **nutrition**. Complete the following:

FN 225.

One quarter of **developmental psychology**. Complete the following:

PSY 215.

One quarter of **sociology**. Complete one of the following:  
SOC 204, 205, 206, 210, 225, 231.

One quarter of **cultural anthropology**. Complete the following:  
ANT 103.

One quarter of **statistics**. Complete one of the following:  
MTH 243, 244.

One quarter of **computer applications**. Complete one of the following\*:  
CIS 120, 121.

\*In lieu of a computer applications course you may attest to your knowledge by completing the proficiency statement.

### **General Education Courses**

Students working towards the completion of their first bachelor degree must complete general education courses, also known as the Linfield Curriculum, prior to graduation from Linfield. (Students working toward the completion of their second bachelor degree are exempt from this requirement.) Students may take these courses either prior to or during their enrollment at Linfield. A course may not meet more than one requirement. The number of courses completed may be used to determine nursing program start date.

**Global Pluralisms.** No additional course required. Satisfied by the cultural anthropology prerequisite.\*

**U.S. Pluralisms.** No additional course required. Satisfied by the sociology prerequisite.\*

**Upper Division.** Not available at Clackamas CC. May be taken at Linfield.

\*If completed at Clackamas CC. If this course is taken elsewhere, it must be a minimum of 3 semester hours or 4 quarter hours to satisfy this requirement.

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
